Alturas Community Day School (ACDS) serves students in kindergarten through sixth grade and strives to provide the most appropriate and best education possible to students who enroll in this alternative education program. The goal of ACDS is to provide individualized and personalized instruction to aid students to re-enter a regular classroom environment

The school is located adjacent to the Alturas Elementary School campus. The classroom is comfortable and attractive and is designed to provide opportunity for group and individualized learning. Computers connected to the internet are available to all students, and several learning programs are available to them electronically. Students in kindergarten through third grade take packets home to complete during the school week. Fourth through sixth graders are assigned homework daily. We expect all students to read for 30 minutes each night. We offer homework assistance through our before-school program and during recess.

Alturas Community Day School begins at 8:15 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. every day. Students receive the number of instructional minutes required by the State of California. Open communication is encouraged with the home and parents are contacted by classroom teacher on positive incidents and achievements as well as concerns. Parents are encouraged to participate in ACDS Site Council and are welcome to volunteer in the classroom and to monitor their student's progress through the district-wide internet AERIES program.
