SFES has a well maintained campus with excellent facilities. The school has two classrooms, a multi-purpose room with a stage, a cafeteria/library with computer stations, and a room that serves as an art room and computer lab. Students and staff have internet access. District maintenance is outstanding in keeping the site in excellent condition. The building has new lighting, doors, windows, and carpeting. New Smart Boards are in use. The library houses books in both English and Spanish. Parents are invited to communicate regularly with the teacher, visit the school and volunteer.
