NOTE: EXPULSION referral is mandatory for "Zero Tolerance" violations; Principals MAY recommend expulsion for any "Serious Expellable" violation if the Principal feels the action is warranted and EITHER of the following has occurred: "other means of correction are not feasible or have repeatedly failed to bring about proper conduct" or that "due to the nature of the violation, the presence of the student causes a continuing danger to the physical safety of the students or others." SUSPENSION may be imposed only when "other means of correction fail to bring about proper conduct; however, a pupil may be suspended upon a first offense for any of the reasons enumerated in EC-48900, paragraphs (a, b, c, d, or e) or the pupil's presence causes a danger to persons or property or threatens to disrupt the instructional process." PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE as outlined in District policies is the recommended action for violations listed as "Minor" or "Serious" violations.
